EDUCATIONAL POLICY OF TOASTMASTERS INTERNATIONAL

The educational policy of Toastmasters International is to fulfill the Mission and Purposes stated in Article I of the Bylaws of Toastmasters International through: (1) research, development, and testing of appropriate programs and materials; (2) promotion of the effective use of such programs and materials; and (3) helping all members develop their full potential in the fields of communication and leadership by offering such opportunities as will meet their needs.

To this end, and to assure consistency of programs and standards of Toastmasters International, member, club and district achievement credit in designated activities will be awarded only for specific programs and activities utilizing materials provided by Toastmasters International.

Members who have developed skills to an advanced level and who wish extended time for the practice of communication and evaluation techniques nearing professional level, may participate in Toastmasters clubs with programs devoted to this purpose.
